Prayer Flash Mobs

For the last few months, we've been organizing prayer flash mobs. Each time, we grow in numbers, and several dozen people show up to pray.

Some people don't realize we continue to pray one hour most days of the week year-round. After attending a prayer flash mob, they realize they can come back more often.

Some people get used to praying on a certain day or at a certain time. By getting involved even once at a different time on a different day, some people have seen how different things can be. For instance, people praying on Mondays that showed up

on a Tuesday saw how much more business Planned Parenthood (PP) does on Tuesdays. People who pray on Tuesdays or Wednesdays see how much less business they do on Fridays.

In July, we met on a Friday. Based on a count of participants and an estimate of the number of clients PP had that day, we believe we had roughly twice as many participants as PP had clients!

We try to provide participants with additional pro-life resources. Come join us next time! We'd love to see you out there!

Crossroads Pro-Life: Northern Walkers

The Northern Walkers from Crossroads Pro-Life Walk Across America passed north of us, in Minnesota and other neighboring states in July. I caught up with them in southern Minnesota.

They invited me to walk with them for a little bit. Their vehicle moves two miles at a time, and then it picks up a group of walkers, as they walk in relay style. Each pair of walkers prays during each leg of their walk, typically



praying the rosary. They wave at vehicles as they pass by.

In joining them for some walking, I experienced the feeling one gets when they see the van ahead, marking the end of that leg.

When I returned after meeting these inspiring young adults, I found out one of our other members saw them up in Minneapolis. They stay in major cities each weekend. They walk until they reach Washington D.C. in mid-August.

For years, I've wanted to meet some of the walkers, and it was wonderful to meet them, no matter how brief it was. I just wish I had remembered that I intentionally packed better shoes for the walk.
